PREST : 8 work packages

- **WP1**: Meetings, exchanges, trainings, management (82 k€)
- **WP2**: Interactions with Cuba installation of 4 seismometers (56 $k \in$)
- **WP3 :** Interactions with Haïti Educations + installation sismo (142 k€)
- **WP4 :** Study of the petites antilles arc in field trip + 6 years postdoc + 18 months engineering + others (709 $k \in$)
- **WP5** : Multiparameters marine plateforme (18 months engineering) 472 k€

One pushbutton acquisition 6 months of recording max Open source electronics (see H. Barrois)






