Activity of Mount Pelée

Saint-Pierre, June 20, 2025, 15:15 local time (GMT-4)

This week, the volcanic activity is characterized by **20 volcanic earthquakes** observed.

Between June 13, 2025 at 16:00 (UTC) and June 20, 2025 at 16:00 (UTC), the OVSM has recorded:

- **18** low-energy **volcano-tectonic** type earthquakes. These earthquakes were clearly identified as originating from one of the well-known seismically active zones on Mount Pelée, located between 1.0 and 1.4 km below the summit of the volcano. Superficial volcano-tectonic seismicity is associated with micro-fracturing in the volcanic edifice related to the overall reactivation of the volcano observed since late 2018.
- **1 long-period** type earthquake located approximately 9 km north-east of Mont Pelée at 20 km depth, with a magnitude of MIv = 1.0. Deep long-period events contain only low frequencies and are associated with the circulation of magmatic fluids deep within the Mont Pelée volcanic system.
- **1 deep hybrid** type earthquake located approximately 6 km north-east of Mont Pelée at 29 km depth, with a magnitude of MIv = 1.5. Hybrid seismic signals are enriched in low frequencies and are also generally associated with the circulation of magmatic fluids in the deep part of Mount Pelée volcanic system.

No earthquake was felt by the population.

The week before, the OVSM had recorded **43 earthquakes** of volcanic origin. As of June 20, and during the last 4 weeks, the OVSM recorded a total of 147 volcanic earthquakes, and an average of **36 to 37 volcanic** earthquakes per week.

During phases of volcanic unrest on volcanoes similar to Mount Pelée, it is usual to observe seismic activity that varies over time in intensity and frequency.
