

## **Taurus Release 1.01.07 Notes**

### **Release Importance:**

Priority 1. Important Update. Strongly Recommended - Perform As Soon As Possible.  
Update affects data availability in Taurus store.

### **Software Improvements:**

- Changed “Sensor Power” default from Off to On. Eliminates interruption of sensor input to Taurus following power cycling or outage.
- Improved timing system performance over wide temperature range
- Eliminated small data gaps caused when operating Taurus in Buffered mode and GPS in automatic mode.
- Power management and improvements to low-level watchdog performance
- Improved NP to NMXP (NAQS) re-transmission operation reducing time to complete re-tx requests.

### **New Features:**

No new features. Maintenance Release only

### **Known Issues:**

This release contains the following operational behaviors or minor bugs planned to be addressed in future maintenance releases.

<b>Issue</b>	<b>Description and Workaround</b>
Switch to Buffered Mode	When changing the Taurus from Communications mode to Buffered mode, the Taurus stays in Communications Mode.  Workaround: On shutdown page, select “Turn-Off Display” to ensure units switches to Buffered Mode
Time-series Download	Occasionally attempting to download time-series data results in “The Store is Closed” message.  Workaround: Close external browser and re-open.
Status Page – No Data Available Message	"No Data Available" showing on the Current status page, while data is updated on the Waveform and Sensor pages.  Workaround: Close the external browser and re-open.
