

Taurus Release 1.01.08 Notes

Release Importance:

Priority 1. Critical Update. Strongly Recommended - Perform As Soon As Possible. Update affects data availability and data recovery in Taurus STORE.

Software Improvements:

- Eliminates CRITICAL problem behavior in STOREs with > 2GB (~ 6 weeks of 3ch @ 100sps) of accumulated data.

Important Notes:

- Without this update, data in the STORE can become unrecoverable by the user.
- Nanometrics will exchange disks of any affected users. The factory can recover data on the users behalf if the situation has been noticed and data storage has been stopped within approximately 24 hours of reaching 2GB.
- When this update is applied (prior to reaching 2GB of accumulated data), the Taurus will continue to acquire data and will self recover all existing data.

New Features:

Known Issues:

This release contains the following operational behaviors or minor bugs planned to be addressed in future maintenance releases.

Issue	Description and Workaround
Switch to Buffered Mode	<p>When changing the Taurus from Communications mode to Buffered mode, the Taurus stays in Communications Mode.</p> <p>Workaround: On shutdown page, select “Turn-Off Display” to ensure units switches to Buffered Mode</p>
Time-series Download	<p>Occasionally attempting to download time-series data results in “The Store is Closed” message.</p> <p>Workaround: Close external browser and re-open.</p>
Status Page – No Data Available Message	<p>"No Data Available" showing on the Current status page, while data is updated on the Waveform and Sensor pages.</p> <p>Workaround: Close the external browser and re-open.</p>
